- exhibits poor hygiene, grooming, or odor
- demonstrates aggression

\_\_\_\_\_ I affirm that the service animal may be removed from UCAS property, events, or functions if the presence of the service animal will require a fundamental alteration or significant disruption of the education process or if the service animal is not consistently performing the trained work or tasks for the individual with a disability.

\_\_\_\_\_ I affirm that the owner/handler of the service animal is liable for any and all damages to property or injuries to persons caused by the service animal. The owner or the handler of a service animal must also indemnify, defend and hold harmless UCAS from and against any and all claims, actions, suits, judgments, and demands brought by any party arising on account of, or in connection with, any activity or damage or injury caused by the service animal.
