What is a Certificate of Completion?

The Certificate of Completion (COC) is a credential awarded by Weber State University that verifies a student has completed the university's General Education (GE) requirements. These requirements are necessary for earning any future Associate or Bachelor's degree and are what is outlined on this document. **Additionally, to earn the COC, a student must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA at WSU, complete at least 10 credit hours through WSU, and apply for graduation.** The COC is recognized by all public colleges and universities in Utah.

¿Qué es el Certificado de Estudios Realizados?

El Certificado de Estudios Realizados (COC por sus siglas en inglés) es una credencial que otorga Weber State University como constancia de que un estudiante ha cumplido con los requisitos de Estudios Generales (GE en inglés) de la Universidad. Estos requisitos, que hay que satisfacer para obtener un título de asociado o una licenciatura, se explican a continuación. Para obtener un COC, hay que mantener un promedio general de calificaciones igual o superior a 2.0 en WSU, cursar por lo menos 10 créditos en WSU y llenar la solicitud de graduación. El COC es reconocido por todas las universidades públicas, tanto las de dos años como las de cuatro años.

Associated Costs

Concurrent Enrollment (CE) credits through Weber State University cost \$5 per credit hour. Most classes are 3 credit hours, totaling \$15. Please note some courses require textbooks, which may increase the overall cost. If you qualify for free or reduced-price lunch through your school district, you may be eligible to take CE classes at no cost. For more information, talk to your high school counseling office.

Tarifas

Se cobra \$5 por cada crédito de Concurrent Enrollment (CE) cursado a través de Weber State University. La mayoría de los cursos son de tres créditos, así que su precio es \$15. Ten en cuenta que algunos cursos requieren libros de texto, por lo que podría subir el precio. Si cumples con los criterios para recibir almuerzos gratuitos o a un precio reducido en tu distrito escolar, es posible que puedas cursar estudios de CE sin costo alguno.
