2. Training: Mrs. Parry talked for a minute about the benefits of Trust Lands and how it could help the school. She also thanked the committee for their commitment to serve. The committee watched a section of the training video and reviewed some specific slides. She asked if there were any questions. Question: How do we determine how to use the money? Is it split among grades? Answer: Let's go to the next agenda item for clarification on those questions.

Mrs. Parry explained described what the first Acadience test showed about where our students currently are in grade-level reading. 45% of students at South Campus are either Below or Well Below grade level reading. She feels that a goal that focuses on supports to increase will be of most benefit to students and will affect every grade level and content area being taught as reading is foundational for all other skills.

 - Paraprofessional to help tutor low level students
 - Software for Tier 2 support
 - Grade Level readers for supplementary materials in each grade
 - Library books for students to have access to reading material at school and at home
 - Professional development opportunities for teachers to increase skill and knowledge
