# Course Description Worksheet

By the end of tonight:

- **11th grade-** choose 1-2 science courses, and four elective classes numbered 1 as first choice and 4 as last
  - 3.0 cumulative GPA required for all Concurrent Enrollment (CE) college courses. High school transcripts are required to verify GPA.
  - Some CE and high school courses require prerequisites or test scores
  - Mark if they are participating in religious release time
- **12th grade-** choose a senior English course, any remaining graduation requirements and four elective classes numbered 1 as first choice and 4 as last
  - 3.0 cumulative GPA required for all Concurrent Enrollment (CE) college courses. High school transcripts are required to verify GPA.
  - Some CE and high school courses require prerequisites or test scores
  - Mark if they are participating in religious release time

- All juniors take Lang Arts 11 H, Math (assigned based on past level and test score), and Student Advisory
- All seniors take ENGL 1010/2010 or high school Lang Arts 12, Student Advisory, and other coursework required for high school graduation

- Apply for SLCC Concurrent Enrollment
  - <https://slcc.edu/concurrentenrollment/Students/admission.html>
  - What you will need to complete the Admission App/Participation Form:
    - Your state SSID number. It begins with either the number 1 or 2 and is a seven digit number. If you do not know your SSID number, ask your high school counselor and administrator for it.
    - Your social security number, unless you are not a US citizen
    - An email address for the student (use a personal email, and remember which one you use)
    - A parent or guardian email address (needed to grant their approval for you to participate in CE)
    - Your first name, last name, birthday, and gender exactly as it appears on your high school record.
    - List Itineris as your high school

Utah public high school students must complete this form to be eligible to participate in the Utah Concurrent Enrollment (CE) program.

Before you start the participation process, check with a high school counselor to learn what concurrent enrollment classes are available at your high school and which colleges sponsor those classes.

To complete this form, you must have:

- if you have one, a social security number, student VISA number, or alien registration number (your citizenship status does not affect your ability to participate in the CE program).
- a parent or guardian present, to read disclosures about CE and grant approval for you to participate
- access to personal email account (student will receive an email with a verification code that is needed to complete the application)

The entire form must be completed in one browser session.

**The information provided on this form is collected securely and will remain confidential. It will be presented only to the institution(s) you select to enroll in concurrent enrollment classes.**

Each public college has different admissions criteria and application fees. When you complete this form and pay the fee(s), your application information will be sent to the college(s) you select. Each college will reply to you directly with its decision to admit you into the CE program and with class registration instructions.

- Watch for your acceptance letter via email and SLCC Student ID number.
  - Keep your S number in a secure place. You will need it to set up your MySLCC account and register for classes.
- Complete your SLCC Placement Testing:
  - <https://slcc.edu/testing/placement/index.aspx>
  - Administered remotely online on a computer (not a smart phone)
  - Results are added to your SLCC records in 24-48 hours
  - Cost of the first test is included in admission
  - Retest fees and policies will apply after the first attempt
  - You will not be able to go backwards in the test
  - Complete your testing in one setting (estimate 30 minutes, but are allowed up to 90 minutes)
