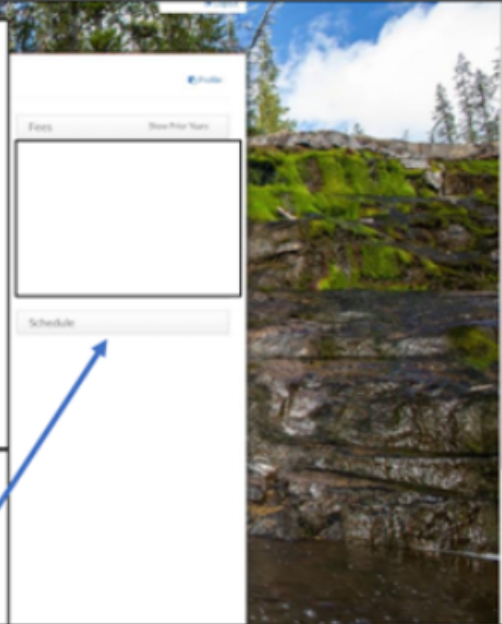

Scheduling by Period

Any course numbers ending in F or ISC are scheduled by counselors only.
