Students Need the Following:

- 1 docket/folder (some type of organizational binder)
- Wired earbuds or headphones (labeled, NOT BLUETOOTH)
- Lined paper and graph paper (college-ruled; refill as needed)
- Pencil pouch for transporting daily supplies (some used daily, others occasionally)
