



Kindergarten Supply List 2026-2027

Your child is provided with everything they need for a successful school year. **NOTICE: The items on the list below will be used during the regular school day. These items may be brought from home on a voluntary basis, otherwise, they will be furnished by the school.** A student may be required to replace supplies provided by the school which are lost, wasted, or damaged by the student through careless or irresponsible behavior.

The following non-instruction items are "appreciated donations": paper towels, tissues, disinfectant wipes, smaller sized Ziploc bags, and hand sanitizer. These types of items may be dropped off in the main office and will be used during the regular school day as well.

Each Student

- 1 pack of small glue sticks
- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (gray included)
- 1 inch 3 ring binder with cover sleeve (no name)
- 1 plastic pencil box (**not Boucher's class**)
- package of large pink erasers (2 total)

Girls

- 1-2 boxes of tissues
