- Verification of completion of the course MUST be turned into the counselor and registrar (1) week prior to the end of the FUHSD grading period/semester. (NOTE: Seniors must follow the deadlines on top)

NOTE: Students MUST be simultaneously enrolled in classes at FUHSD schools while attending an off-campus class. You may NOT do part time schedules at FUHSD schools and part time at off campus locations. Students must attend FUHSD schools for the required number of periods. (See student handbook.)

WARNING: The off campus course you have requested as a graduation requirement for FUHSD MAY NOT be accepted by the UC/CSU system, private colleges, universities, out of state institutions, or NCAA as fulfilling entrance requirements. Be sure to check with an admissions officer from each campus to which you intend to apply.

(Students MAY NOT enroll in courses if less than 30 days left in grading period.)
