

UCAS 2025-2026 Fee Schedule and Spend Plans

- All fees may be waived with an approved fee-waiver application and supporting documentation. Students may appeal the school's decision if the school denies a request for waiver.
- Donations to cover the cost of students on fee-waivers are accepted. UCAS is a 501(c)3 organization.
- The student annual maximum fee, which may be charged for a student's participation in all courses, programs, and activities provided, sponsored or supported by the school is \$2000.

Fees for Classes and Activities During the Regular School Day

<u>Fee</u>	<u>Maximum Charge</u>	<u>Spend Plan</u>
Concurrent Enrollment Science	\$35/class taken	Purchase supplies for labs plus textbook, and/or other in class resources and instructional supplies.
Concurrent Enrollment Art	\$20/class taken	Purchase instructional equipment for projects throughout the semester using a variety of media. Each class fee will be assessed annually to ensure supply cost is in line with the fee.
Math 1050 Concurrent Enrollment	\$15	Digital curriculum used in the course.

Fees for Classes and Activities Outside the Regular School Day

<u>Fee</u>	<u>Maximum Charge</u>	<u>Spend Plan</u>
Driver's Education	\$175	Offset the cost to provide class and behind the wheel instruction along with gas and other vehicle maintenance costs. Course includes non-interactive simulators, 5 behind the wheel drives, and one road test.
Additional Road Test	\$25	Offsets the cost to provide an additional road test for students who need one.
Additional Drives	\$30/Drive	Offsets the salary given to the instructor for additional drives outside of those provided in the initial course. Also offsets the cost of gas for these drives. Drives can be purchased upon request and with approval of the instructor.
PSAT Test	\$20	UCAS will charge the actual cost of the test.
AAPPL Test	\$25	UCAS will charge the actual cost of the test.
National Honor Society	\$10	Covers a portion of the cost to register with the NHS organization, offsets the stipend paid to the advisor, covers costs incurred during club activities, and offsets the cost of meetings.
Yearbook Club	\$50	Offsets the cost of supplies and equipment for the yearbook club and clothing worn by members.
Hope Squad	\$50	Offsets the cost of supplies and equipment for Hope Squad and clothing worn by members.

Student Council	\$50	Offsets the cost of clothing worn by the members. Only the actual cost of clothing will be charged.
Science Olympiad	\$30	Offsets the cost of supplies for competition and attendance at the competition.
Robotics Club	\$30	Offsets the cost of supplies for competition and attendance at the competition.
Overnight Trip (in-state)	\$400	Offsets the cost of in-state overnight travel associated with school activities or clubs.
Overnight Trip (out-of-state)	\$1800	Offsets the cost of out-of-state overnight travel and accommodations associated with school activities or clubs.
Credit Recovery	\$100	Offsets the cost for Independent Study for either credit recovery or original credit. Only the actual cost of the course used and the instructor salary will be charged.
Dance Ticket	\$5/dance except Prom	Personal, discretionary charge for students who choose to attend the dance. DJ, decorations, ticket printing, etc.
Prom	\$50	Cost of DJ, decorations, ticket printing, entrance to venue, catering, etc.
Graduation Rental	\$70	Cost of maintenance for regalia. \$20 is refundable upon rental return. Offsets the cost of graduation venue.

Non-Waivable Charges

These charges are personal and discretionary student purchases and are not subject to fee waiver provisions.

<u>For</u>	<u>Maximum Charge</u>	<u>Spend Plan</u>
Yearbook	\$50	Personal, discretionary charge for students who desire a yearbook.
Senior Party	\$50	Personal, discretionary charge for students who attend the party. Food, prizes, etc.
Graduation Purchase	\$170	Purchase of regalia. Rental of regalia can be waived (see above). Only actual cost of regalia will be charged.

Student Fines

These charges are fines to continue utilizing the UCAS scholarship at UVU. Other fines may be assessed for damage to school property. These fines will not exceed the cost of replacement of damaged item.

<u>Fine</u>	<u>Maximum Charge</u>	<u>Spend Plan</u>
Scholarship Breech	\$175/credit hour	Offsets the cost of tuition paid to UVU when a student fails or drops an on-campus class past a published date.
Property Damage	Varies	Cost to replace lost, stolen, or damaged UCAS property.
