## Toilet Trained Assurance Form for All Students

In accordance with HB331 School and Classroom Amendments, students must be toilet trained before entering school. Children must be wearing underwear. A child having accidents daily would NOT be considered toilet trained. Please note that wearing pull ups is NOT considered toilet trained.

We do understand that even toilet trained children will occasionally have accidents. By definition, "accidents" are unusual incidents and should happen infrequently. In these instances, it's helpful to have an extra set of clothes in the students' backpack so they can change on their own, encouraging independence as much as possible.

A toilet trained child is a child who can do the following:

- \* Communicate to the teachers that they need to go to the restroom before they need to go
- \* Alert themselves to stop what they are doing, to go and use the bathroom
- \* Pull down their clothes and get them back up without assistance
- \* Wipe themselves after using the toilet
- \* Get on/off the toilet by themselves
- \* Wash and dry hands
- \* Postpone going if they must wait for someone who is in the bathroom or if we are away from the classroom

A qualifying diagnosis/plan must be in place or in progress before the start of the school year to qualify for an exception under an IEP/504.
