



BOARD POLICY ON BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND SUPERVISION OF SCHOLARS

The Governing Board desires to make available before-school and/or after-school enrichment programs that support the regular education program and provide safe, constructive alternatives for scholars. In order to increase academic achievement of participating scholars, the Governing Board will endeavor to identify programs which are aligned with John Adams Academies, Inc's mission, vision and goals for scholar learning, and its curriculum. However, while intended to be complementary, such programs shall not be an integral or fundamental or required part of the curriculum or identified as a extra-curricular programs. Rather, they are selected for their value to provide parental support.

The offering of any program on campus shall be approved by the Board and the Headmaster or designee of each participating school.

A program may include academic and enrichment elements. If the program is determined, based upon the involvement of John Adams Academies in supporting or assisting in the program or other factors, to be curricular or extra-curricular per Education Code section 49010 et seq., then no fees shall be charged, but voluntary donations may be solicited and accepted.

A fee may be charged to participating families for purely custodial care programs based on the actual cost of services. At the election of the service provider, any fee may be waived or subsidized based on economic disadvantage or other critical needs in accordance.

The Executive Director or designee shall develop procedures to maintain oversight over operation and safety of such programs and scholars after school hours.
