



Middle School and High School Event Policy

1. Doors close one half hour after the event begins. No in/out privileges. No exceptions.
2. Events at JAA are for scholars in regular attendance at JAA. Scholars who have 10 or more unexcused absences will not be admitted.
3. Scholars who have been suspended on or off campus, or have been expelled are not permitted at events.
4. Scholars with more than one D (or any Fs) will not be admitted.
5. Scholars/guests must be picked up promptly, following the event. Scholars/guests who have not left or have not been picked up within 30 minutes will lose future dance privileges. Additionally, local authorities will be notified in the event that a scholar is not picked up from the event.
6. Scholars/guests must display a current year student I.D. to be admitted. No exceptions.
7. Dance Conduct: Scholars/guests shall dance in an appropriate manner. Unsafe, lewd, or vulgar dancing is not permitted. Scholars/guests who choose to dance in an inappropriate manner will be asked to leave the dance immediately, without warnings.
8. Smoking and drinking illegal substances is not permitted. Possession of drugs or alcohol is not permitted. Any scholar/guest suspected of being under the influence will be: tested and removed from the event; both parents and law enforcement will be called in such cases; suspended for five days; and may be recommended to the Board of Trustees for expulsion.
9. Possession and/or use of weapons is not permitted. Any scholar/guest who is in possession of a weapon, or uses an item as a weapon, will be: removed from the event; both parents and law enforcement will be called in such cases; suspended for five days; and may be recommended to the Board of Trustees for expulsion.
10. Scholars/guests shall dress appropriately according to the theme of the event. School dress code will be enforced (see next page for details).
11. Scholars/guests who violate any of these rules will be removed from the event, and parents will be called for immediate pick up.
12. Repeated violations of any rule above may exclude a scholar/guest from future events.

Guest Pass Policy:

1. A JAA scholar may request permission to bring a guest who does not attend JAA to the dance.
2. Before a guest from another school may attend, however, a guest pass must be completed and submitted to an Administrator of Secondary Education by Wednesday, prior to the dance. No exceptions.
3. Guest must be in high school.
4. Guest must arrive with and attend dance with JAA host scholar and...
 - a. Present a current student I.D. No exceptions.
 - b. Comply with all JAA rules, regulations, and dress code policies.

Academy-Sponsored Dress Code:

While the uniform is not required, scholars are expected to adhere to the same minimum standards as the daily uniform. Modesty will be expected: no bare skin or midriff, no low cut or revealing clothing, and shorts will not be allowed. Dresses must have a minimum two (2) inch-wide strap and dresses and skirts must touch the knee.

Scholar Parking:

All scholars who drive to the dance will be asked to park in the first row to the left, in front of the Washington Building parking lot, as directed by a chaperone. Should scholars/guests decide to leave the event early, they must leave immediately, and will not be granted re-entry to the event.
